

Dear Members of Holden and Trinity,

I have prayed that in some way we could get some Bible studies going at Trinity and Holden congregations. I worked with Pastor John Spaulding while at Faith Lutheran in Morris. I remember him saying, "Unless you know stories about Jesus from the Bible how can you know Jesus?" Paul scolded the Corinthian Christians for their unspiritual studies and conduct (1 Corinthians 3:1-4). He explained that their problems were caused partly by some of them having too little knowledge of God's ways.

Growing spiritually through regular and meaningful personal Bible study is vital. We learn God's ways by carefully reading and reflecting on the meaning of His instructions. Consider the attitude toward God's Word and his law expressed in Psalms 110:97-104: "Oh, how I love your law! I is my mediation all the day. You, through your commandments, make me wiser than my enemies; for they are ever with me. I have more understanding than all my teachers, for Your testimonies are my meditation. I understand more than the ancients, because I keep Your precepts."

We have the opportunity to study God's word. Rodger Brandt has offered to begin a study. He has set the time for 10:00 on Thursday but it wiling to change if it's not a good time for you. Don't let this opportunity pass you by. We are so blessed having Rodger offer to do this. I know if you attend once you will continue attending and you will grow in your knowledge of God and the scriptures.

1. Life touch photography has a full schedule.


2. Trinity website: Jody has updated some. More is needed. Looking for someone willing to keep the outside sign updated.
